14.01 RESPONSIBILITIES OF LIAISON COMMITTEES

- Acts as a service agency to its parent organizations and discusses and recommends solutions of problems of mutual interest.
- 2. Adopts administrative regulations subject to approval of ICHP and other participating organizations.
- 3. Makes recommendation to parent organizations for approval.

14.02 GUIDELINES FOR LIAISON COMMITTEE

- 1. The Illinois Council of Health-System Pharmacists (ICHP) may participate on liaison committee(s) on an ad hoc or permanent basis with health professions or other organizations as the need arises.
- 2. The number of representatives on a liaison committee from each organization shall be approved by the Boards of Directors of the organizations involved.
- 3. Each ICHP representative to a Liaison Committee is appointed by the ICHP President and approved by the ICHP Board of Directors.
- 4. The purpose of a Liaison Committee is to act as a service component and communication link between the parent organizations.
- 5. Each Liaison Committee elects a Chairman and Secretary and adopts administrative regulations subject to approval by the Boards of Directors of each parent organization.
- 6. Liaison Committee(s) discuss problems of mutual interest to each organization. Recommendations are made based on alternatives studied by the Committee.
- 7. All recommendations of a Liaison Committee are subject to approval by the Boards of Directors of each parent organization.
- 8. A representative of ICHP appointed to a Liaison Committee is not authorized to commit ICHP in any manner without prior approval of the Board of Directors.
- 9. The minutes of each Liaison Committee meeting are submitted to the Executive Vice President of ICHP for distribution to the Board of Directors.
