<u>Traditional Role of a</u> Pharmacy Technician

A pharmacy technician works closely with pharmacists and other healthcare professionals in diverse settings such as hospitals, clinics, community pharmacies and Specialty pharmacies. Technicians perform vital functions to support the patient care efforts of the pharmacy team with roles and responsibilities that continue to expand and evolve.



Precepting

Precepting is the process by which experienced personnel provides coaching, direct instruction and role modelling to a less experience individual.






A call to action:
