HB3497:

- Amends the Pharmacy Practice Act
- State Board of Pharmacy shall consist of 11 members (rather than 9 members)
- 8 members (rather than 7 members) shall be licensed pharmacists
- One of the licensed pharmacists shall have a primary site for the practice of pharmacy at an inpatient hospital pharmacy
- Adds one member who is a pharmacy technician

The Board of Pharmacy does not have representation from inpatient pharmacy services. There are very different processes and levels of service provided from the hospital pharmacy versus the community pharmacy. It is crucial to have a hospital pharmacist on the Board in order to speak to laws and regulations affecting healthcare and hospital pharmacy. In addition, pharmacy technicians play an important role in both hospital and community pharmacies and should be represented on the Board. We urge you to vote YES on HB3497.
