- **Hot Topic – Mary Ann Kliethermes (for Brian Cryder)**

Brian Cryder suggested discussion on The Philosophy of Practice for Comprehensive Medication Management: Evaluating Its Meaning and Application by Practitioners in the January ACCP (sent out by email). The article discussed an ACCP grant to help study the value of Comprehensive Health Management. Authors are from UNC and University of Minnesota where CMM is practiced. They identified 5 core tenets which much be included at the outset of any philosophy of practice. This philosophy seems to be missing from hospitals and ambulatory care services.

The group mentioned they were surprised how few patients they reviewed in a week and that the age of these patients was fairly young. We really do not have an idea in Illinois who is practicing ambulatory care or what services they provide. Starlin has tried to get a survey sent out with not much success. It was suggested that it might be good to have individuals from UNC or Minnesota give a keynote on this issue.

Perhaps meet as a group at the Spring Meeting to network on this topic and then create a program for the Annual Meeting on various protocols being used in Illinois.

No report ○ Government Affairs – Scott Meyers See above ● Open Forum Dan discussed his presentations on pharmacist managed Oral Contraceptive prescribing. Pharmacists hesitate to prescribe due to liability. In fact, the larger chains do not allow their pharmacists to do so due to this issue. There has been opposition in Illinois for the last 3 years to allow pharmacists to prescribe oral contraceptives. The primary opponents are the Illinois State Medical Society and the Nursing Society. Dan mentioned that the medical residents frequently ask him to handle is for them. Brooke Griffin mentioned that in California, reimbursement became an issue. In Oregon, they incorporated the reimbursement issue in the law, so it did not become an issue. Both Dan and Brooke would be willing to assist in speaking to legislators about this issue. Scott Meyers mentioned that it is key to get physicians speaking in favor of pharmacist managed programs.
