a. Ambulatory Care Pharmacist Billing

Starlin: Survey in Illinois about pharmacist billing

Revision of survey led to greater response

CDC wanted to know how many pharmacists are involved in education

Over 300 responses from survey

Separated questions between management and pharmacists, survey showed

Discrepancy between perceptions of having enough time to provide patient education

In more rural counties, the greatest need was present

Telehealth rules relaxation could help in providing more education to patients

20% of managers were health system managers

Possible redo survey and resend

2 main issues: Reimbursement and time

Brooke: Ideal of Billing Champion

Someone can take lead on educating rest of ICHP on billing practices

Forming task force instead of relying on certain individuals

We should develop goals for task force over next 6 to 9 months

Finalize the group members, send out documents.

Mary Ann: Billing Champion Task Force would be great

This would work both on a local and national level

On national level, confusion on billing for pharmacist services widespread

ASHP survey on telehealth results are in – will use it to help on case for relaxation on tele visit rules. 80% were telephone visits only.

People may not have video/audio capabilities on their end

Mean visit was about 30 minutes

30% of patients improved with telehealth

55% did not try to bill

Most were comprehensive medication reviews

George Washington University have white paper about barriers to pharmacist providing care

Important to figure out how to maneuver through billing regulations (OT vs Auxiliary care providers)

Starlin: no matter what arena you are in, there is a pharmacist that is helping with care

Physician Fee Schedules should be coming out soon

We have many FAQ, updated yearly. Download the PDF and search.

Zoom meeting to review document?

For fiscal year, going to be offering certificate programs with focus on counties south of highway 70. Converted all of the processes to a virtual training program. Rural hospital in Harrisburg, creating a TOC program working with Dietician and, two critical care hospitals, two independent pharmacies to provide care to local physicians
