##### TECHNICIANS:

1. Describe how to increase provider awareness of the data available through PMP and PMPnow.
2. Identify methods of improved accessibility that have contributed to increased utilization of PMP.
3. Summarize the CDC recommendations for prescribing opioids in patients with chronic pain.
4. Identify patients at risk for experiencing opioid related toxicity through risk assessment factors.

8. Explain how to integrate identification and steps of opioid overdose management when counseling others on naloxone, as an essential role of all healthcare professionals.
9. Compare key elements of administration and access to all four formulations of naloxone with consideration for the IL standardized procedures and naloxone statewide standing order.
10. Recognize the importance to support bystander response by obtaining and carrying naloxone to be able to respond to an opioid overdose in the community.
