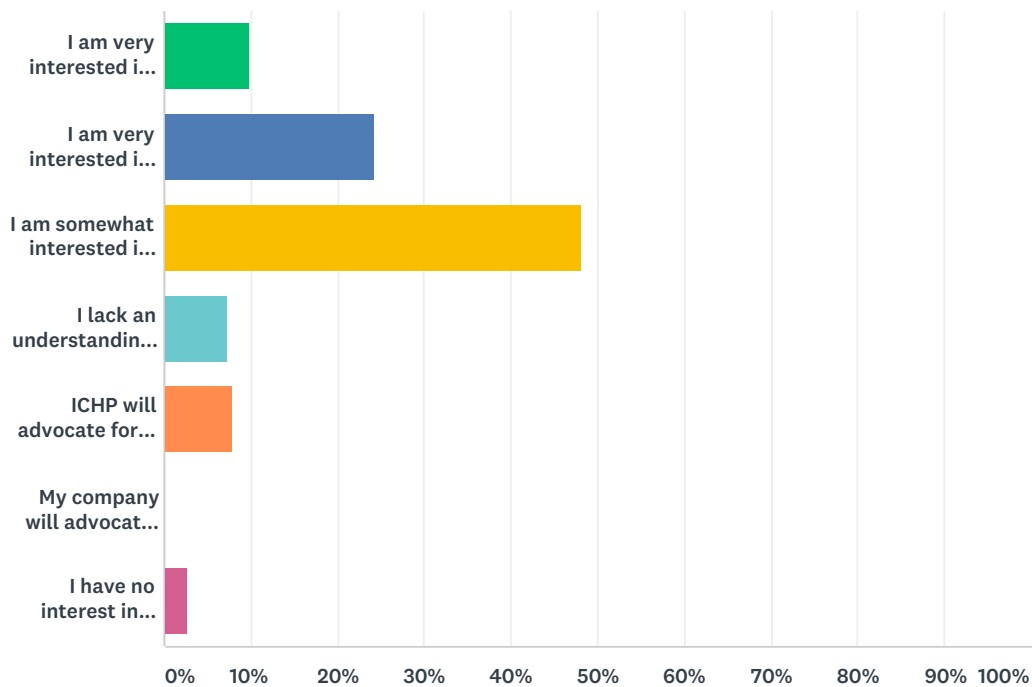


Q1 Select the statement that best aligns with your interest / perception of advocacy (please choose one):

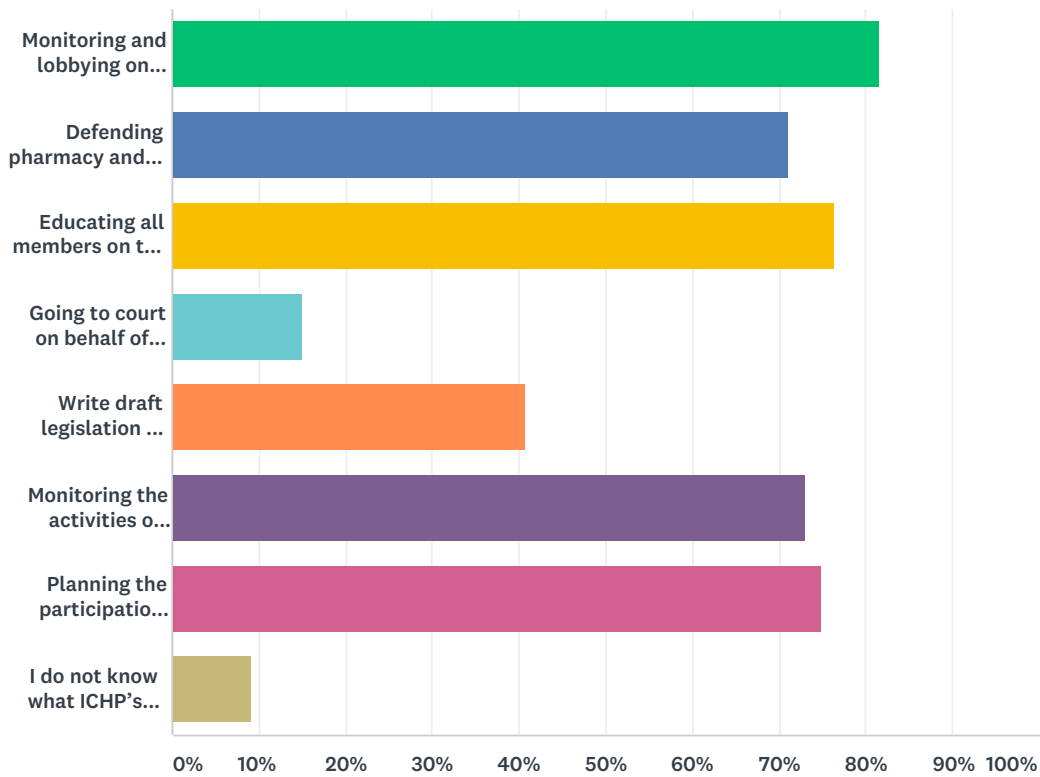

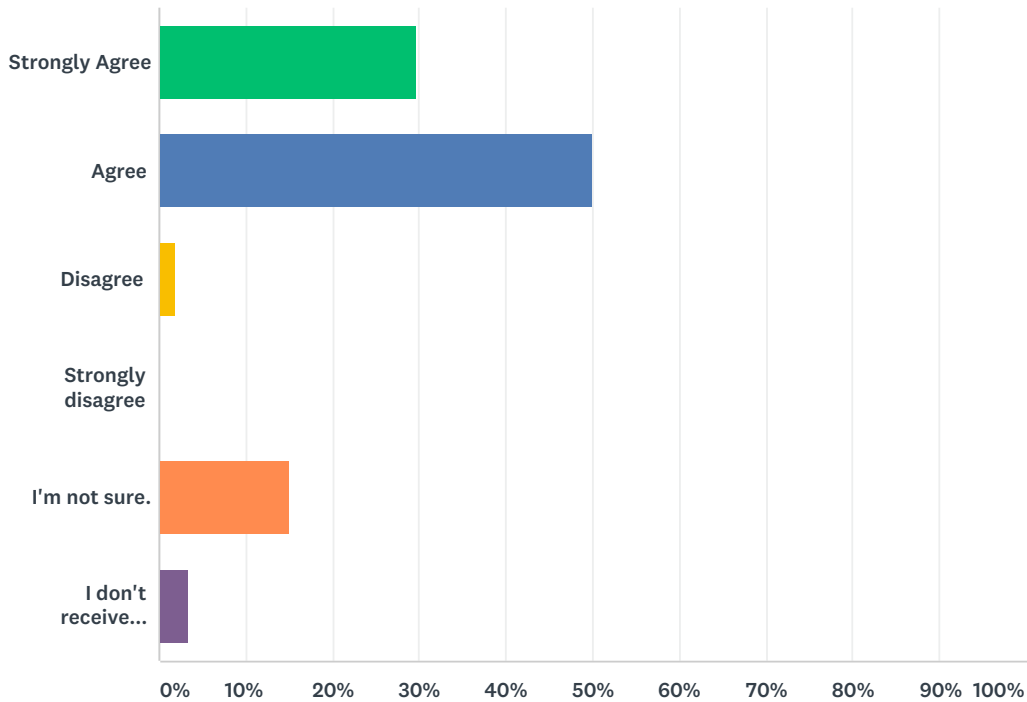

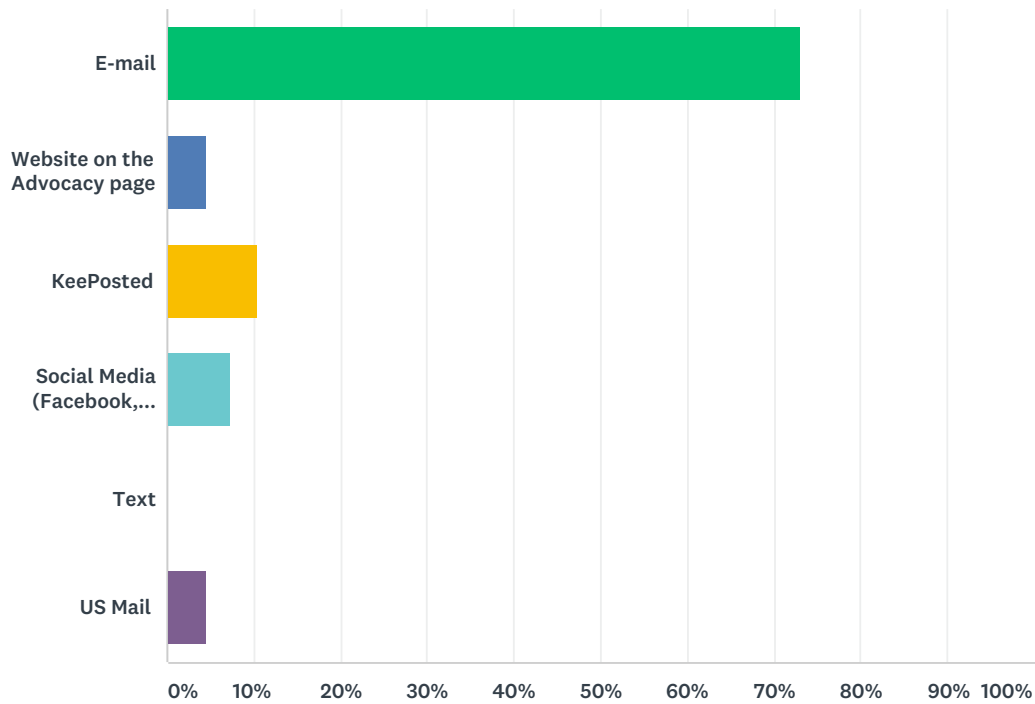

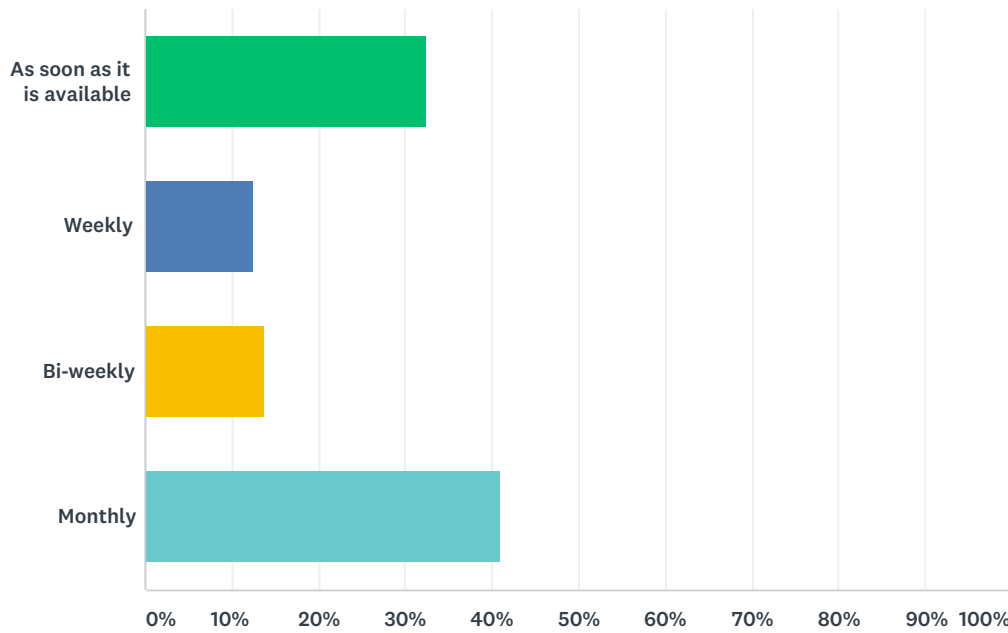

Q5 How often would you like to receive this advocacy (legislative and regulatory) information? (Please choose one.)

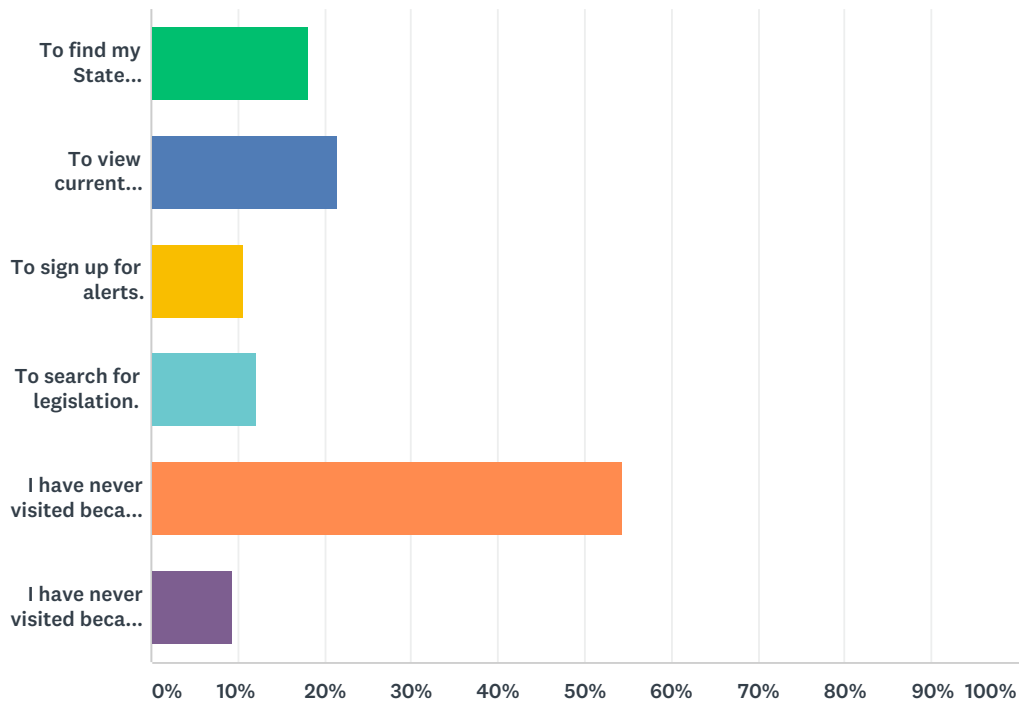

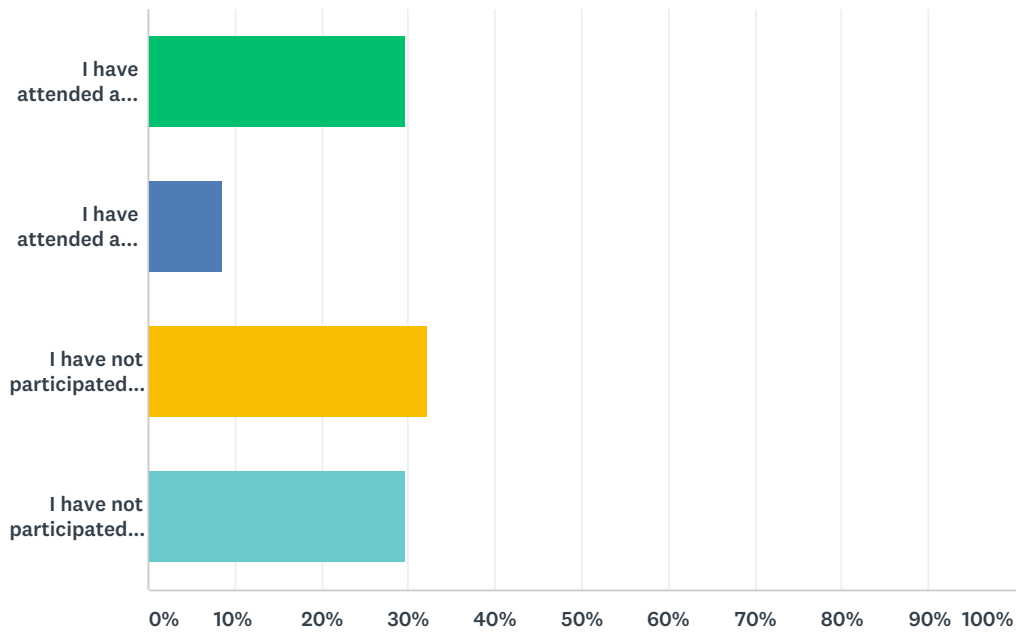

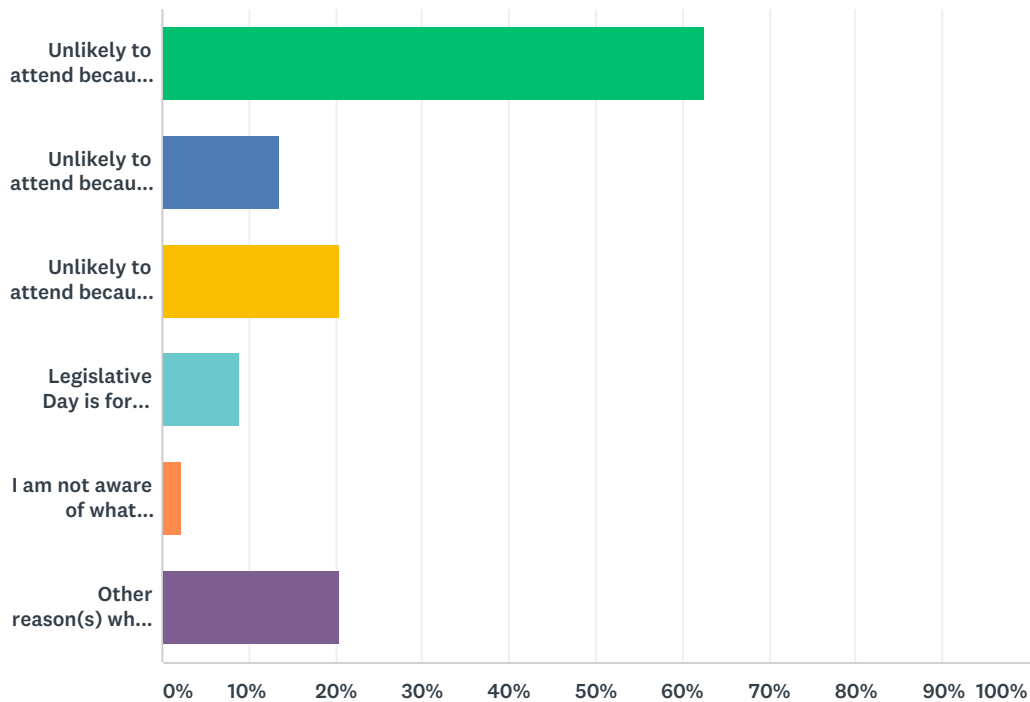

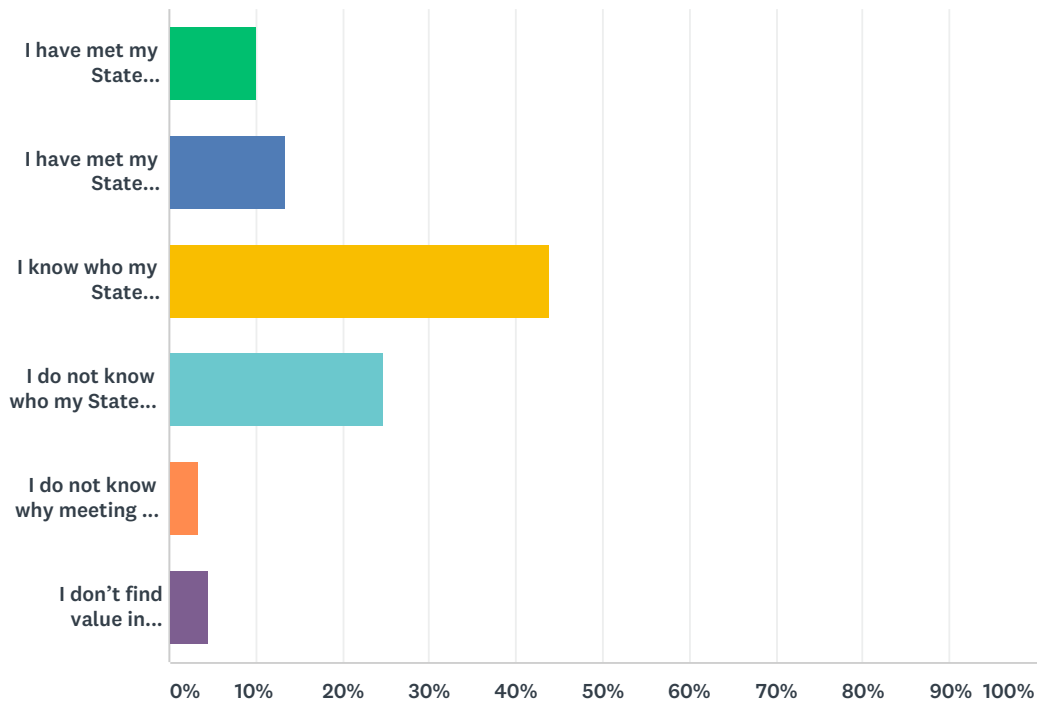

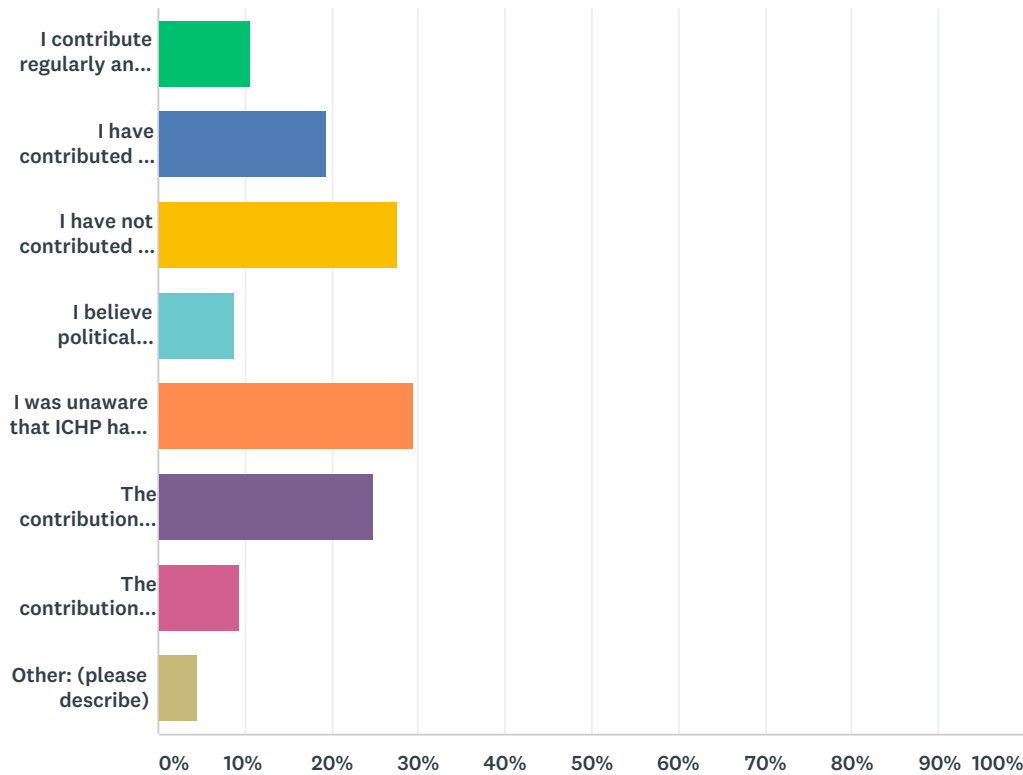

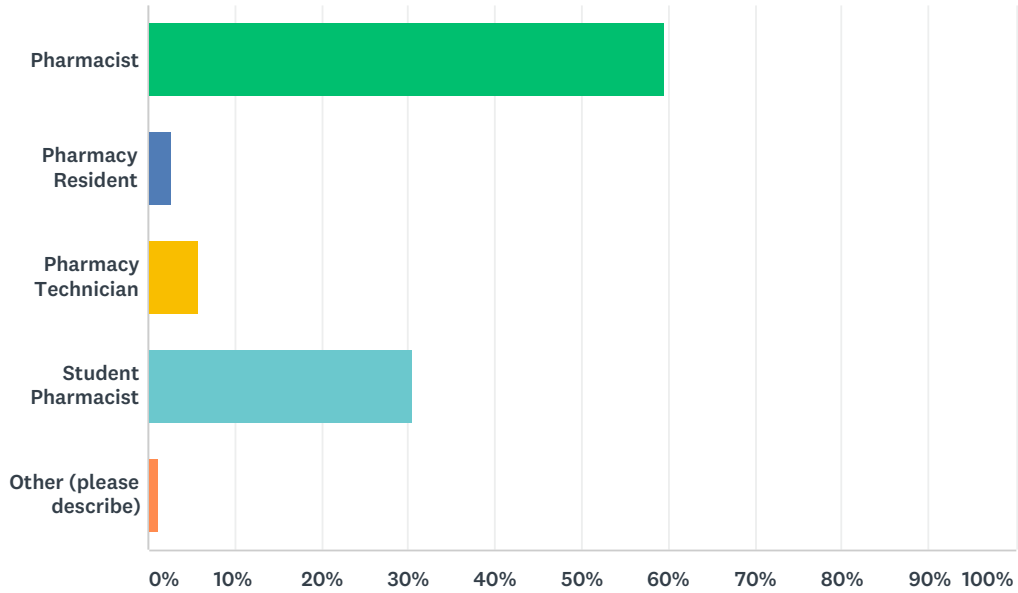

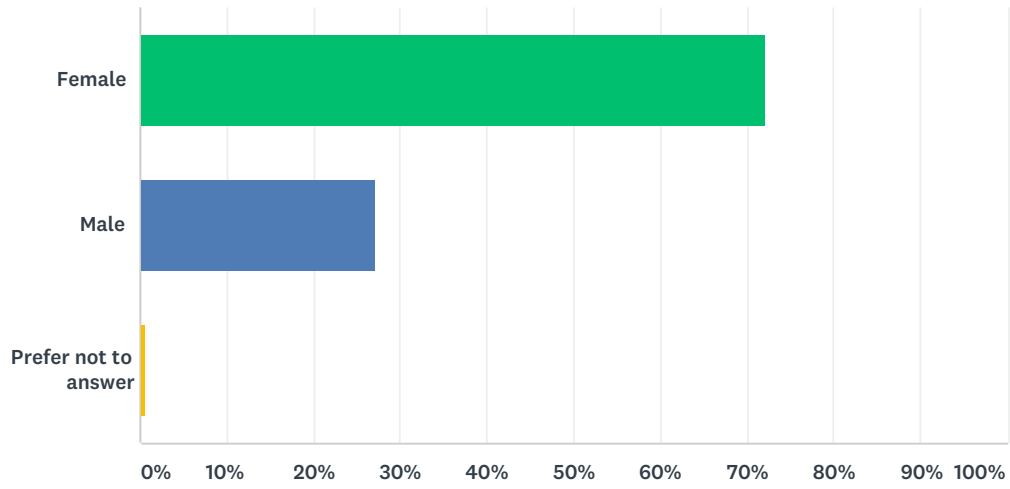

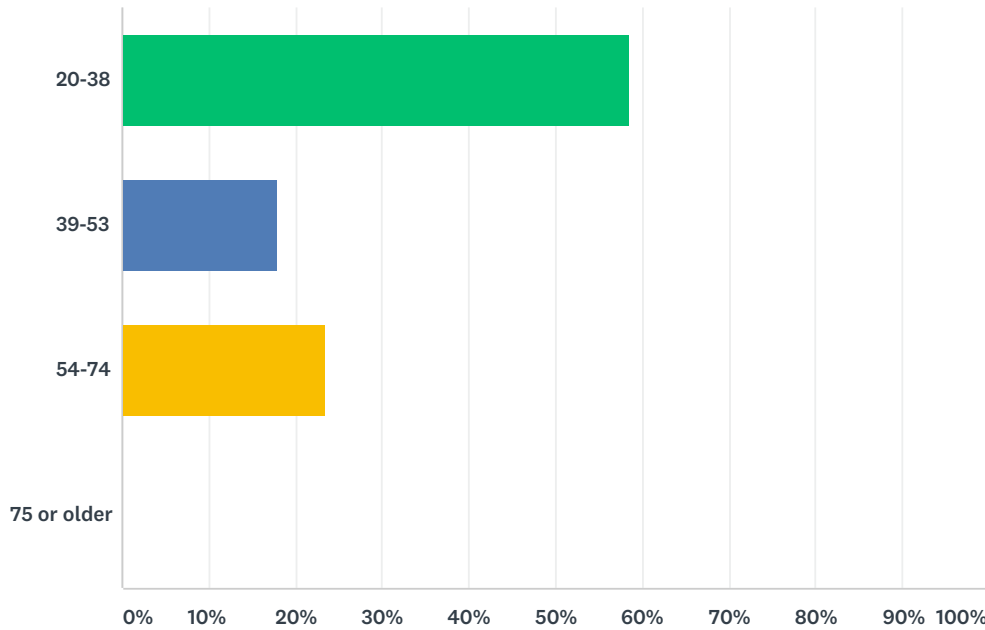

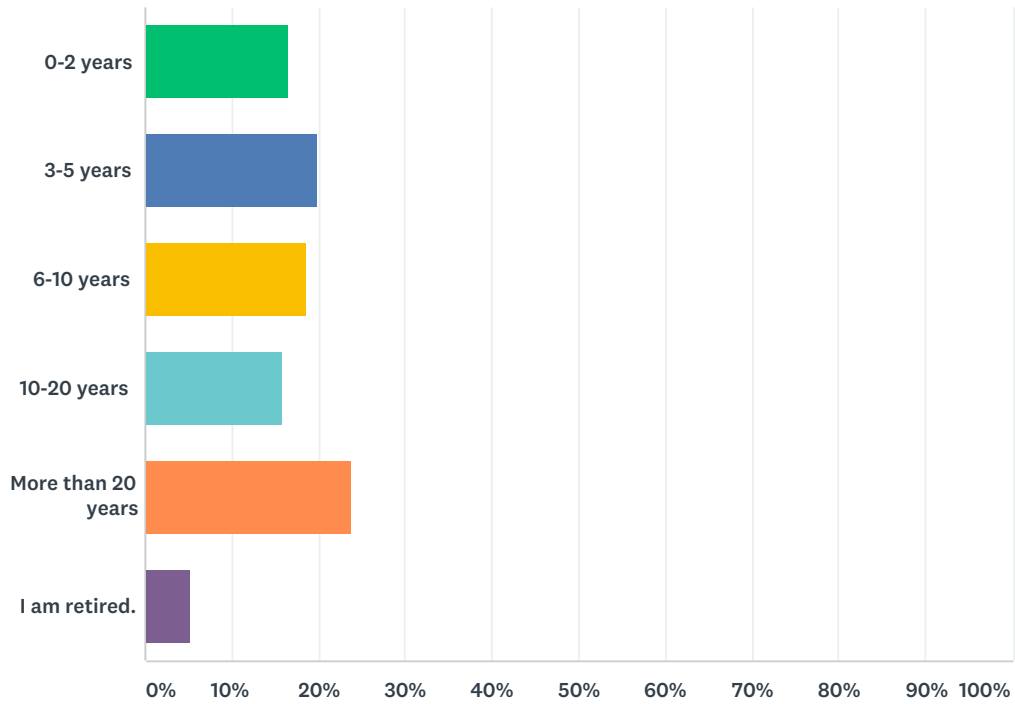

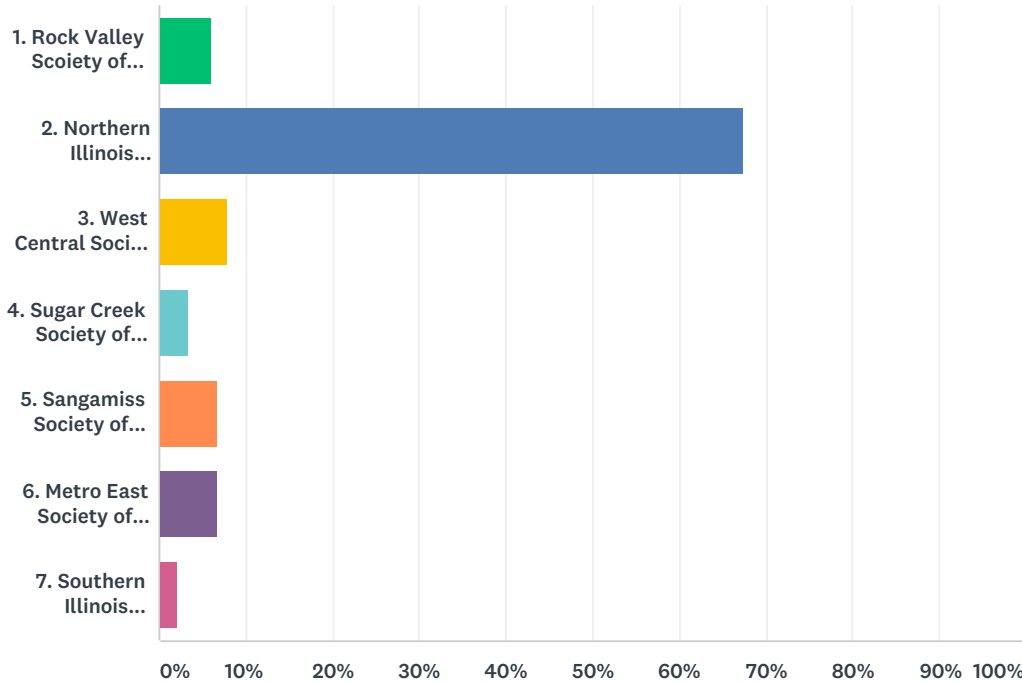
